GENERAL PURPOSE

To contribute in ensuring the protection of migrants in Tunisia according to national and international agreements through the improvement of their access to the right to health according to an integrated medical and psycho-social approach.

BENEFICIARIES

Foreign migrants in a vulnerable situation regardless of their status (authorized, unauthorized, refugees/asylum seekers, sea survivors, human trafficking victims, students, workers, unemployed...).

ACTIVITIES

I. PROVIDING MEDICAL AND PSYCHO- SOCIAL SERVICES

1. Medical Services :

- Free general medical consultations.
- Assistance in healthcare facilities.
- Orientation and referrals to specialists and healthcare facilities.

2. Psychological Services:

- Free psychological assistance and support (by a psychologist).
- Orientation and referral to a psychiatrist if needed.

3. Social Services:

- Orientation and referral to partner associations and organizations.
- Awareness campaigns among migrants regarding health issues and the healthcare system in Tunisia.
- Outreach in locations where migrants live, work and study.
- Migrants' assistance in healthcare facilities

II. IMPROVEMENT OF MIGRANTS' RECEPTION IN PUBLIC HEALTHCARE FACILITIES

1. Training staff on migrants' rights.
2. Awareness-raising and prevention against discrimination.
3. Implementation of a network of institutional health partners.

III. ADVOCACY FOR MIGRANTS' RIGHTS

Advocacy will be performed in partnership with other organisations of the civil society to the following authorities:

1. Ministry of Public Health.
2. Ministry of Social Affairs
3. Assembly of the Representatives of the People of Tunisia.
